TO ENTER, CHOOSE **ONE** OF THE FOLLOWING ROUTES:

1 DRAW IT

Complete an illustrated 6-panel storyboard of your epic journey. Include descriptions to briefly explain the story and any other technical details you'd like us to know.

2 SHOOT IT

Either: Tell a story by taking 6 photos. Include descriptions to briefly explain the story and any other technical details you'd like us to know.

Or: Using only 6 shots, create a short film of your epic take on an 'everyday' event (max 2 mins).

3 WRITE IT

Tell your story using the power of words! Write 6 x max. 100-word paragraphs/verses (max. 600 words in total) of descriptive writing for an epic retelling of an everyday event.

Entries will be judged on their quality and creativity, particularly the entrant's use of visual, audio and/or written tools to transform 'the everyday' into 'the epic'.

Please note: learners are asked not to use any copyrighted material or AI in the creation of their competition entry.

Please be advised that *The Odyssey* has been rated **15** by the BBFC.

How to enter: young people can complete their entry on the reverse side of this form, OR using a blank piece of paper, OR an MP4 file for filmed work.

Entrants aged 17 and under must include details of an authorised adult (18+) to include:

- The authorised adult's name and email address, *provided as permission for the young person (people) to enter*
- The young person's first name, age and school name.
- Confirmation that consent has been given by a parent or guardian for any person under 17 who appears in filmed or photographed content.
