What is the Youth Advisory Council?

We have 5 regional Youth Advisory Councils that make up our UK-wide Council.

They are:

- **England North and Midlands**
Covering the North and Midlands of England
- **England South**
Covering South East and South West England
- **Wales**
Covering all of Wales
- **Scotland**
Covering all of Scotland.
- **Northern Ireland**
Covering all of Northern Ireland.

As a member of the YAC you will join a group of like-minded young people from across your region and help us make the Into Film programme appealing, accessible and interesting to young people.

You will get the chance to provide feedback on a range of stuff; from the Into Film website, to what films we screen at events; from how we support cinemas, to inform young people on careers in film.

We want you to tell us what you think – what you like and dislike, and how we can get more young people watching, thinking and making film!

What you get:

- A chance to influence what we do in your region and across the UK
- An opportunity to be part of a Youth Advisory Council where you meet other young people with a passion for film
- Exclusive previews of new Into Film content, activities and competitions
- A chance to develop key skills; such as communication, teamwork and problem solving.

Into Film's Youth Advisory Council has been running across the UK for several years and during that time we have supported young people from all backgrounds, including young people who live with a disability or have a learning difficulty. We work and discuss with the parents/guardians and young people to try to make the YAC as inclusive as we can.

If accepted on to the scheme we would ask about phobias, triggers and other things that would be good for us to be aware of – if you'd like to share that with us.

As a member of your regional panel, you will:

- **Attend** online or in-person quarterly meetings. It is likely that we will run 1 face-to-face during the YAC year.
 - » Under 18s need to have an adult present in the background but not on camera and for face-to-face meetings, under 18s will need to be dropped off and picked up by an adult.
 - » If you require technical support in accessing online meetings, we can support you. Don't be put off applying!
 - » All travel expenses to and from any face-to-face meetings will be covered by Into Film.
- **Tell us** what you think about a wide range of film-related topics.
- **Ask** friends at school/college/youth group for feedback on some of our projects and activities.
- **Test out** new activities and take part in sessions before they are launched.
- **Commit** to being a member of your regional YAC for one year, running August 2025 to July 2026 with the potential of staying on for the second year after completing the first year.
- **Develop and harness skills**, such as team work, communication, presenting, and more. The YAC is a great initiative to help boost your Further Education/Higher Education applications and CV.

If you are over 18 you will be required to undertake a DBS check; this is standard for any adult working or volunteering with under 18s.

Into Film will talk through this simple process if you are asked to join the YAC and cover the costs involved.

OPTION 1 In Writing

OPTION 2 On PowerPoint/Google Slides or similar

OPTION 3 Send us a Video

OPTION 4 Audio only

Look at the questions below and produce a short audio file (this can be done via Voice Memo on your phone) covering the answers to each question below.

If you're unable to upload your video/audio or slide file on the Application Form, then there is an alternative approach, you can send your file to us via We Transfer by following the below guidance.

How to send in your PowerPoint, Video or Audio format application if you're unable to attach it to the application form.

To send in PowerPoint/Slides, Audio or filmed application:

1. With a guardian/parent visit www.wetransfer.com (we are aware that We Transfer now charge to use their services, please select the free trial process of 3 days and we will ensure we download your video within that time).
2. Click the 'Add your files' button on the left hand side and select the PowerPoint/Slides/Audio or Video clip you want to send, then click 'Open'.
3. In the box underneath called 'Email to', enter yac@intofilm.org for safeguarding purposes, enter your guardian/parent's email address in the box below. Over 18s can use their own email address.

4. In the 'Message' box you can write a short message to accompany your slides, audio, or video and please add your first name, regional YAC you're applying to and the first part of your home postcode (for example SA1). Then click 'Transfer' to send the clip, this may take a few seconds.

5. Once the clip and message have been sent, your guardian/parent will receive a confirmation email or if over 18, you will.
