### What is My Place?

My Place is a filmmaking, archive project for young people from Northern Ireland.

Young people, aged 14-19 will be asked to take part in 4 virtual sessions with a professional film maker, learning about editing films and using archive footage to edit and enhance recordings.

Once finished the final project will then be displayed to the public, and shared widely in the form of a QR code.
